



## Position Overview

The Junior Petroleum Engineer will be responsible for participating in a multi-discipline team that supplies technical support to the Company's Egyptian and Canadian assets. The successful candidate will initially report to the Engineering Manager – Technical Services.

### Responsibilities:

- Work in multi-discipline team to identify, evaluate, prioritize, plan and execute workover, optimization, and acquisition opportunities;
- Analyze, interpret and optimize individual well performance across multiple fields in the Company, as directed;
- Maintain effective communication with the Technical Services Group, the Egypt Subsurface team and the Canadian team, as required;
- Participate in building and tracking of the annual budget and quarterly updates;
- Assist in reviewing 3<sup>rd</sup> party reserve evaluations and aid in the preparation of annual and quarterly reserves presentations to the Board of Directors;
- Conduct reservoir studies and participate in the forecasting of future production volumes, as required;
- Assist in the preparation of various government/regulatory applications in both Egypt and Canada;
- Assist in evaluating potential acquisitions worldwide, as required;
- Provide economics evaluations on all projects/duties above, as needed.

### Qualifications:

- APEGA Engineer in Training or Professional Engineer with 5 to 8 year's oil and gas experience.
- Willingness to learn and take initiative.
- Some experience in economic evaluations, production forecasting and optimization, fundamental reservoir engineering skills and reserves assessment is required.
- Excellent communication, organizational and leadership skills, complemented with a strong work ethic is essential.
